The maximum QCO credit donation amount for 2023:
\$421 single, married filing separate or head of household; \$841 married filing joint.

Please Note: Arizona law allows QCO donations made during 2023 or donations made from January 1, 2024, through April 15, 2024 to be claimed on the 2023 Arizona income tax return. The maximum credit that can be claimed on the 2023 Arizona return for donations made to QCO's is \$421 for single, married filing separate or head of household taxpayers, and \$841 for married filing joint taxpayers.
